

Is Game Fishing Expensive?

It depends on how you go about it. Most game fishing in Victoria is performed from trailer boats generally ranging from 5 -7 metres in length. There are 12 metre "battle-wagons" but these are the exception rather than the rule.

An ideal way to experience game fishing for the first time is to join a club.

Game fishing is a team sport and joining a club allows novice game fishers to meet experienced anglers and to seek out opportunities to learn the ropes.

Most skippers are very understanding and don't require novices to bring any equipment while they are learning.
